### **SUPPLY LISTS:**

- a. We will need tables and chairs for participants to work. I will be showing PowerPoint presentations throughout the lecture. I will provide the projector and computer, but I will need a three-prong extension cord and a screen.

  - About a dozen 4 x 6 blank index cards
