WARP FAST: LEARN TO WARP MORE THAN ONE THREAD AT A TIME!



Using PowerPoint, students will learn to use devices that allow warping multiple ends at the same time. Discover the inexpensive rigid heddle warping paddle, and the fast method of sectional warping. Explore the advantages and disadvantages of this production technique. The

AVL warping wheel will also be discussed as well as detailed information on calculating warps especially for multiple thread repeats.

Students will have a better understanding of speed warping processes using multiple ends at a time. The digital slide lecture allows a quick overview of a complex process, explaining the equipment involved. A must for production oriented weavers. The less expensive paddle method can be used by any weaver and is a terrific time saver. My goal is to speed up a process that can be laborious for some, allowing the weaver to warp mixed yarns and repeats more efficiently.
